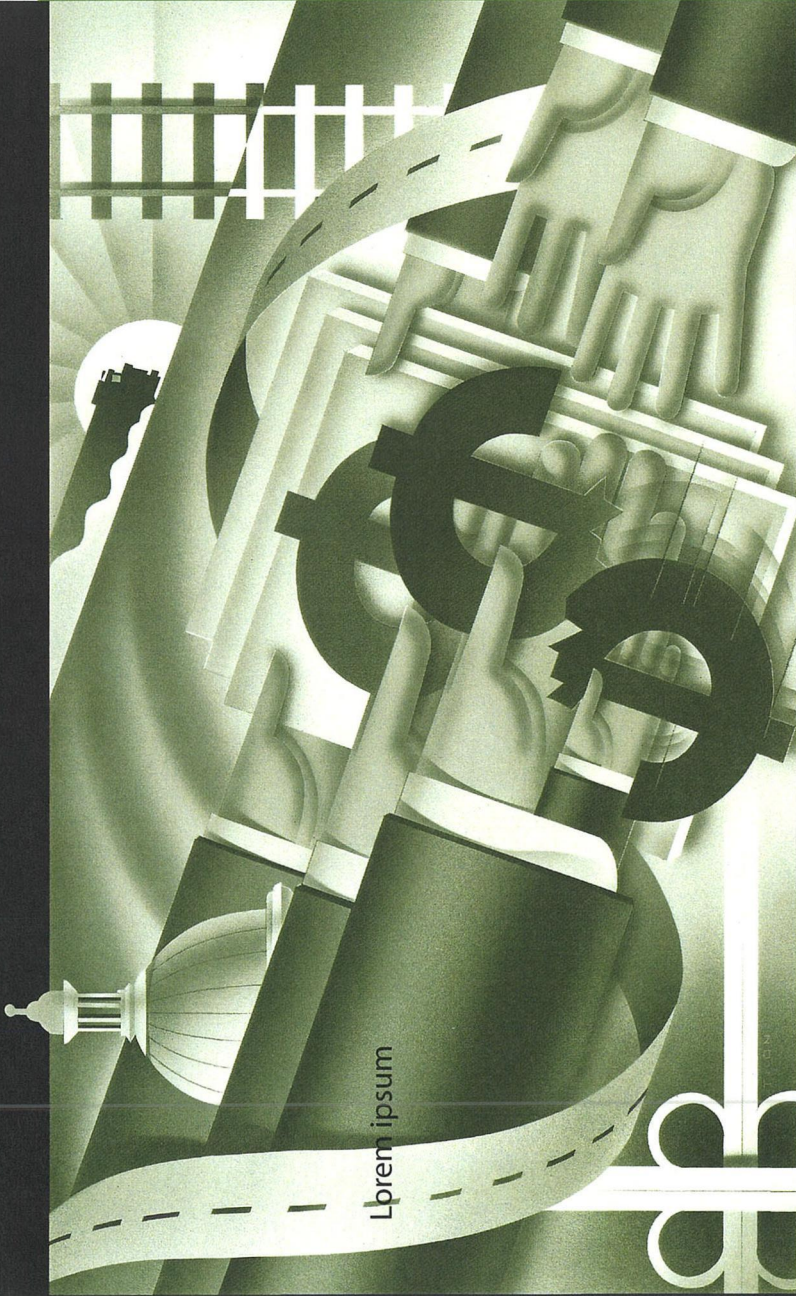

The federally required Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is a comprehensive listing of Bay Area surface transportation projects that are to receive federal funding, are subject to a federally required action, or are considered regionally significant for air quality conformity purposes. The TIP covers a four-year period and must be financially constrained by year, meaning that the amount of dollars committed to the projects (also referred to as “programmed”) must not exceed the amount of dollars estimated to be available. All projects included in the TIP must be consistent with the current Regional Transportation Plan (RTP), Amended Plan Bay Area 2040, and the TIP must be analyzed to determine if the program complies with or “conforms to” federal air quality plans (known as the State Implementation Plan or SIP) and regulations. The Draft 2019 TIP includes projects “programmed” in four fiscal years: FY 2018-19, FY 2019-20, FY 2020-21, and FY 2021-22.
