- Provide 1.1-mile Mostly Grade-Separated Protected Bike/Ped Path
- Connect West Oakland to Bay Bridge Trail
- Provide Family Friendly Bike/Ped Connection
- Eliminate Bike/Ped Conflicts with Trucks and Railcars
- Improve Shoreline Access to Communities

- Safe and Low Stress Bike/Ped Connection (Family Friendly)
- Low-Cost Mobility Option
- View of Bay, Shoreline & Skyline
- Improve Recreation Access


