The federally required TIP is the region's transportation funding document containing surface transportation projects and anticipated funding over the next four years. The projects are expected to receive federal funds, be subject to a federally required action, or are regionally significant. Federal air quality regulations require an air quality conformity determination on the TIP. The Draft 2023 TIP was released for public review on July 5, 2022.
